
Project Title: Big Goose Creek Sewer Interceptor

Project Location: The proposed project includes installation of a new sanitary sewer transmission main following Loucks Street from West View Dr. east to Badger Street and then through Kendrick Park.

Description and Justification: The existing sanitary sewer system lacks capacity to accommodate future development west of Sheridan in the Big Goose Valley.
